
+ I work in independent practice or have left paid employment to provide rehabilitation nursing care to a family member (do not have a supervisor or CRRN colleague). Am I still eligible?

4 STEPS TO CRRN® CERTIFICATION

1. PREPARE

Check your **eligibility** and review the CRRN® Candidate Handbook for full details.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates must meet the following criteria at the time of application:

- Current, unrestricted US, US territories, or Canadian RN licensure; **AND**
- Completion of at least one of the following at the time of application:
 - **Two years** of practice as a registered professional nurse in rehabilitation nursing within the last five years; **OR**
 - **One year** of practice as a registered professional nurse in rehabilitation nursing and one year of advanced study (beyond baccalaureate) in nursing within the last five years.

2. APPLY

You're ready to apply! Apply online through the Certification Center and choose to take your exam at a test site or remotely online with a live proctor.
