Legislative Priorities

Support Chronic Care Reform

Recommendation: ARN supports efforts to improve the care provided to individuals with chronic illnesses.

Support Requiring a Registered Nurse in the Nursing Home

Recommendation: ARN supports requiring nursing homes to have at least one direct care, registered nurse (RN) with specialized training or experience in rehabilitation on duty 24 hours per day, 7 days a week

Support and Promote Appropriate Quality Measures and Outcomes Across the Post-Acute Care Continuum

Recommendation: ARN supports efforts to ensure harmonious and equal measures across the post-acute care continuum.

Preserve Access to Quality Rehabilitation Services

Recommendation: ARN supports efforts to ensure that individuals with disabilities and/or chronic illness have access to comprehensive, quality care in the setting that is most appropriate for them.
