



## **Fellow Worksheet**

Use these 7 prompts to complete the application.

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1. List ARN National or Chapter Leadership for elected or appointed leadership role (ARN leadership examples would be a chair/co-chair of a committee or taskforce or being on the board – this is either at a local or national level – intent is that you are the lead not a member of committee/taskforce)  
List in date order, beginning with most recent involvement.

2. List ARN National and/or Chapter Activity Involvement for non-elected or appointed non-leadership role). This is involvement in activities that you have done in ARN – committee membership, presentations/posters at ARN, community service with ARN, fundraising for RNF, etc.  
**FORMAT:** *List in date order, beginning with most recent involvement. Include the group project name, position held and dates.*

3. What has your community involvement been within the US or internationally? (The intent of this question is determining involvement that supports rehabilitation practice outside of ARN activities)

List in date of order:

- Geographic location
- Position Held
- Dates of Activity
- Activity Description

4. List publication citations in relation to rehabilitation and nursing. These will support your ARN and/or Community Involvement activity.

**FORMAT:** *APA-style format information that includes author names(s), date of publication, title of publication, journal or text in which publication is contained. Please bold your name in the citation*

5. List Research: Provide a description that shows information about researcher names(s), title of research, dates of research, institution/affiliated entity.

6. List honors and awards you have received.

7. Describe what you consider to be your most outstanding contributions to rehabilitation nursing and relate your contributions to the criteria for selection of Fellows. Use this as an opportunity to provide personal meaning about how you have made a difference.

- My actions have had impact in the following ways (consider using statements that can completely and in detail show impact such as):
  - I have inspired...
  - I caused... to occur
  - I led other to...
  - I discovered...
  - I brought rehab nursing to the table for...
- My accomplishments have enduring impact because (consider using statements that can completely and in detail show how they endure such as):
  - They are published and available to...
  - They are codified in...
  - They advance knowledge, skills, and behaviors...
  - They contribute to standards...
  - I created enduring *knowledge, tools, interdisciplinary...* that will be used into the future
